VOLUNTEER CODE OF ETHICS

- 1. Smoking or use of tobacco products in the presence of children is prohibited.
- 2. Using, possessing, or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
- 3. Volunteers shall not abuse children including:

Physical Abuse – strike, spank, shake or slap

Verbal Abuse – humiliate, degrade or threaten

Sexual Abuse – including inappropriate touching or exposure

Neglect – withholding food, water, basic care, etc.

- 4. Volunteers must treat children of all races, religions and cultures with respect and consideration.
- 5. Volunteers must use positive techniques of guidance, including positive reinforcement and encouragement rather than competition, comparison or criticism.
- 6. Volunteers shall abstain from humiliating or frightening discipline techniques.
- 7. Volunteers shall not use profanity in the presence of children or parents.
- 8. Volunteers will refrain from intimate displays of affection toward others in the presence of children, parents and staff.
- 9. Monetary and expensive gifts to volunteers are prohibited.
- 10. Volunteers must be free of physical and psychological conditions that might adversely affect children's health, including fever or contagious conditions.
- 11. Volunteers will portray a positive role model for youth by maintaining an attitude of respect, loyalty, patience, integrity, courtesy, tact and maturity.
- 12. Volunteers will do everything in their power to avoid being put in a situation where they are alone with a YMCA child other than their own.
- 13. Caring for any YMCA children other than your own on a one-on-one basis, such as baby-sitting is prohibited.
- 14. Volunteers must not enter bathrooms with any child.
- 15. Volunteers are not to arrange future contact with YMCA children.
- 16. Illinois State Law requires that all citizens report any suspected abuse or neglect of a child to the Champaign County Department of Social Services, Child Protection Unit.
- 17. I understand as a volunteer for the YMCA I may be subject to a background check, including criminal history.
- 18. I understand that allegations or suspicions of child abuse are taken very seriously by the YMCA and will be reported to the Champaign County Department of Social Services, Child Protection Unit for investigation and that the YMCA will fully cooperate with any related investigations and will pursue the prosecution of child abusers to its full extent under the laws of this State.

Violation of this Code is subject to, but not limited to, removal as a volunteer. I have received, read and agree to the items listed on the Volunteer Code of Ethics and Rules.
